## **Frequently asked Questions**

(OTHER QUESTIONS SHOULD BE DIRECTED TO THE FAIR OFFICE AT 330-633.6200)

### **WHERE DO WE FIND A DISPLAY BOARD AND WHAT SIZE DO WE NEED?**

Most office supply stores carry a tri-fold, cardboard display board. (Cost between \$5 - \$8)  
The size of the board should be 48 inches wide x 36" high when open and  
24 inches wide x 36 inches high when folded OR as close to this measurement  
as possible

### **WHEN DO THE DISPLAY BOARDS NEED TO BE DROPPED OFF AND WHERE?**

Display Boards can be turned into the fair office before July 23<sup>rd</sup> at 4pm OR at the Arena Complex  
on July 16<sup>th</sup> during Grade and Exhibit.

### **HOW DO WE CHOOSE A TOPIC?**

The specific topic will be assigned to each club by random draw.  
A list of each club and their assigned topic will be available on our website and  
distributed by mail to Club Advisor

### **WHAT SUPPLIES CAN BE USED?**

There are no restrictions

### **WHERE DO WE PLACE OUR CLUB NAME?**

On the bottom right corner, on the back of the board place your club and advisor name.  
(the Fairboard will provide a basic sign, with the club name, to place in front of your display board)

### **IS IT MANDATORY TO DO A DISPLAY BOARD?**

If your club wants to receive wristbands, at no cost, for admission to the fair, it is necessary for  
each club to assemble a club booth and turn in an educational display board

### **WHAT AWARDS CAN WE RECEIVE?**

Rosettes to 1<sup>st</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> Place  
Participation Ribbon to all others
