CAMPING RULES DURING THE 2011 4-H HORSE CAMP

CAMPING DEADLINE FOR 4-H HORSE CAMP: JUNE 1st

- 1) Those using campers or motorhomes are NOT permitted to use outside refrigerators. Those using only a tent may use a portable refrigerator but it must be kept inside the tent.
- 2) Each camper must have UL approved 3 conductor electric cords.
- 3) The fee for camping entitles you to camp starting Sunday, June 19th. The premises must be vacated by 8:00 p.m. on Friday, June 24th.
- 4) Lots are NOT assigned. Instead, lots will be issued as follows:
 - a. The first grass area against the fence (northern most part of campground) shall be reserved for tents. Additional grass areas may be designated for tents if needed once registrations are received.
- 5) **Each site must have** adult supervision. For clarification, the adult must be 21-years of age or older.
- 6) Once camping fee is paid, a camping permit card will be issued and must be placed in or on your camper or tent at all times. Card must be visible from the road. Only those campers or tents with proper identification are permitted to camp during the 2011 4-H Horse Camp. Permits are picked up at the Saddle Horse Bldg.
- 7) At the close of horse camp each day, all Howe Road gates will be locked. You will have access from Gate B only.
- 8) Camping spots are to be kept clean of trash/rubbish at all times. You are responsible for placing your trash in the proper receptacle.
- 9) There is a fee of \$30 for NSF checks.
- 10) The Summit County Agricultural Society reserves the right to revoke camping privileges (without refund) for any rule violation or acts of misconduct.
- 11) The use of golf carts is NOT permitted.
- 12) Open fires are NOT permitted.
- 13) Alcoholic beverages are NOT permitted.
- 14) The curfew in the campground shall be 11:00 p.m.
- 15) Camping privileges are being granted as a convenience for those attending horse camp. The Summit County Agricultural Society will not provide security during this period.
- 16) **WHEN APPLYING FOR CAMPING PRIVILEGES, YOU AGREE THAT YOU WILL FOLLOW RULES SET BY THE Summit County Agricultural Society, Summit County Saddle Horse Association, and Summit County Junior Leaders in regards to Horse Camp and staying at the Fairgrounds.**
