

## **HORSE SHOW Rules due to COVID19**

- 1) SPECTATORS MUST MAINTAIN SIX FOOT SOCIAL DISTANCING
- 2) Participants must conduct daily symptoms self-evaluation and if experiencing symptoms must stay home
- 3) All individuals must avoid physical contact with others including high fives.
- 4) Equipment that is not owned by you must be sanitized before use.
- 5) If you test positive within 14 days after the show please contact show officials.
- 6) Spectators should wear face coverings
- 7) Participants are encouraged to travel to show with only family
- 8) All individuals should avoid congregating in common spaces or parking lots, before, during or after the show.
- 9) When not showing participants are encouraged to wear face coverings.
- 10) Only family members may sit together to watch the show (limit 10 in one group)
- 11) It is encouraged that you bring your own chairs to sit and watch.
- 12) Hand Sanitizing stations at barn, entry booth, by food stand and ring
- 13) No award hand out in the rings, awards will be available to participants in the entry booth with no contact



## **BARN RULES**

- 1) Six Foot Social Distancing Rule (families may help tack and ready the horse)
- 2) All individuals should avoid congregating in common spaces before, during or after the show
- 3) Anything that is frequently touched must be sanitized on a regular basis

## **BATHROOMS**

- 1) Must be sanitized before the show and will be sanitized each hour

## **VOLUNTEERS**

- 1) Must Wear Masks when helping with public and maintain social distancing with each other and the public.
- 2) Must wash hands before volunteering
- 3) Must do an evaluation of volunteers if experiencing symptoms must stay home or be sent home.
